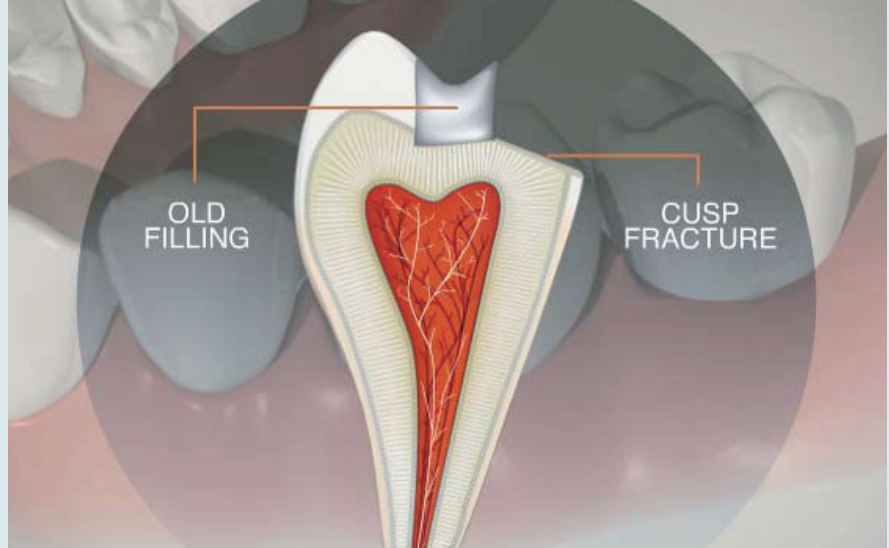
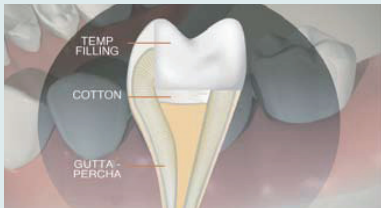


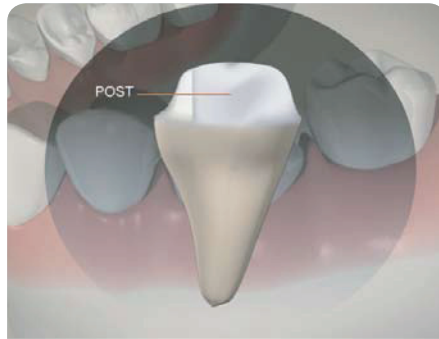
Cusp Fracture - Direct Post & Core

When a tooth is fractured deeply, damaging the pulp, a root canal is required.

The steps below demonstrate the direct post and core restoration used in conjunction with a crown restoration. Your dentist or hygienist, will be able to answer any questions you have about this procedure.



Gutta-Percha replaces the pulp to keep the tooth strong. The direct post is then cemented in place.



The tooth is then prepared for the crown. A temporary crown may be cemented in place while the final crown is custom made at the dental lab.



Once the final crown is finished, the temporary crown is removed and the final crown is cemented in place.
